

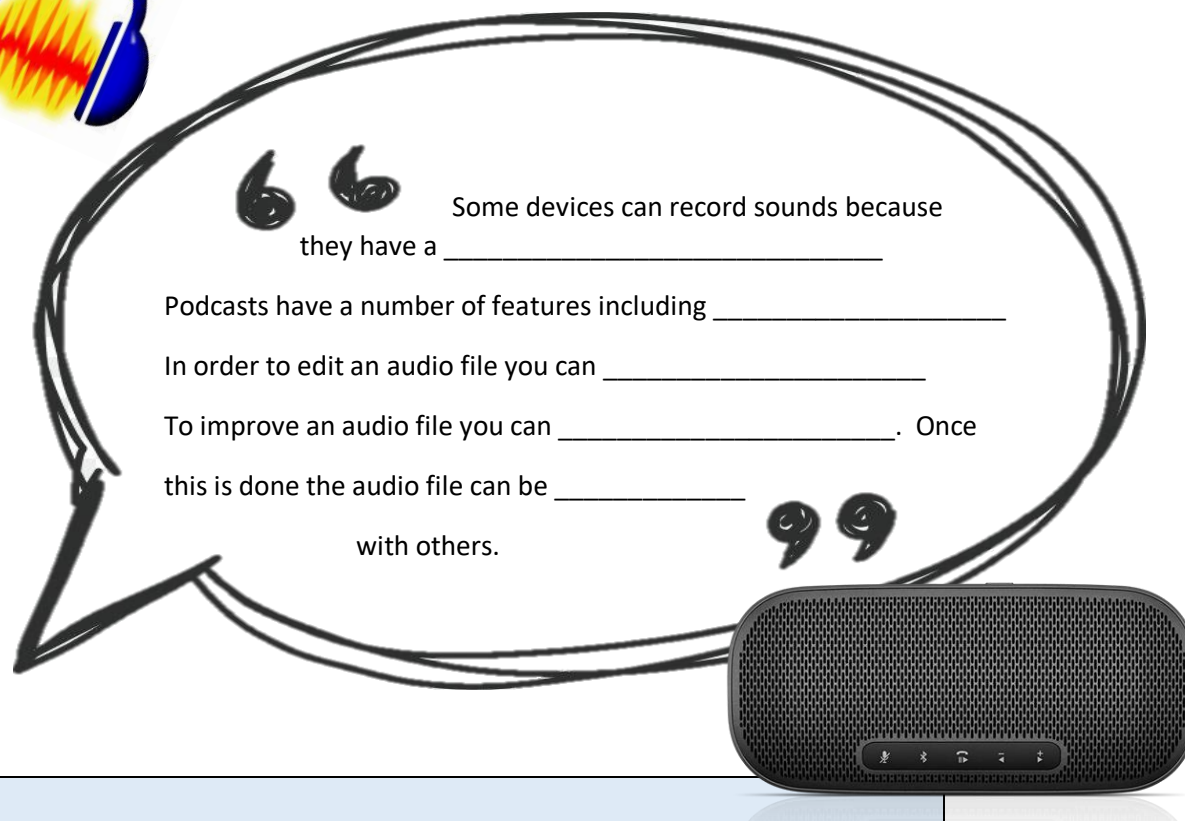

Creating media – Audio editing

Key Facts

- devices can play audio, record sounds, or do both
- devices can have inputs (microphone) and outputs (headphones or speakers)
- the features of podcasts include: voices, jingles, sound effects, background music, presenters' names, podcast name, introduction
- an audio file can be changed by editing
- audio files can be combined, or mixed, with existing digital recordings and exported as an audio file
- digital recordings need to be exported to share them
