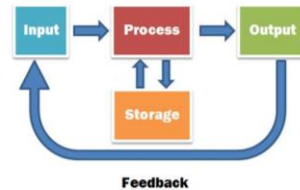

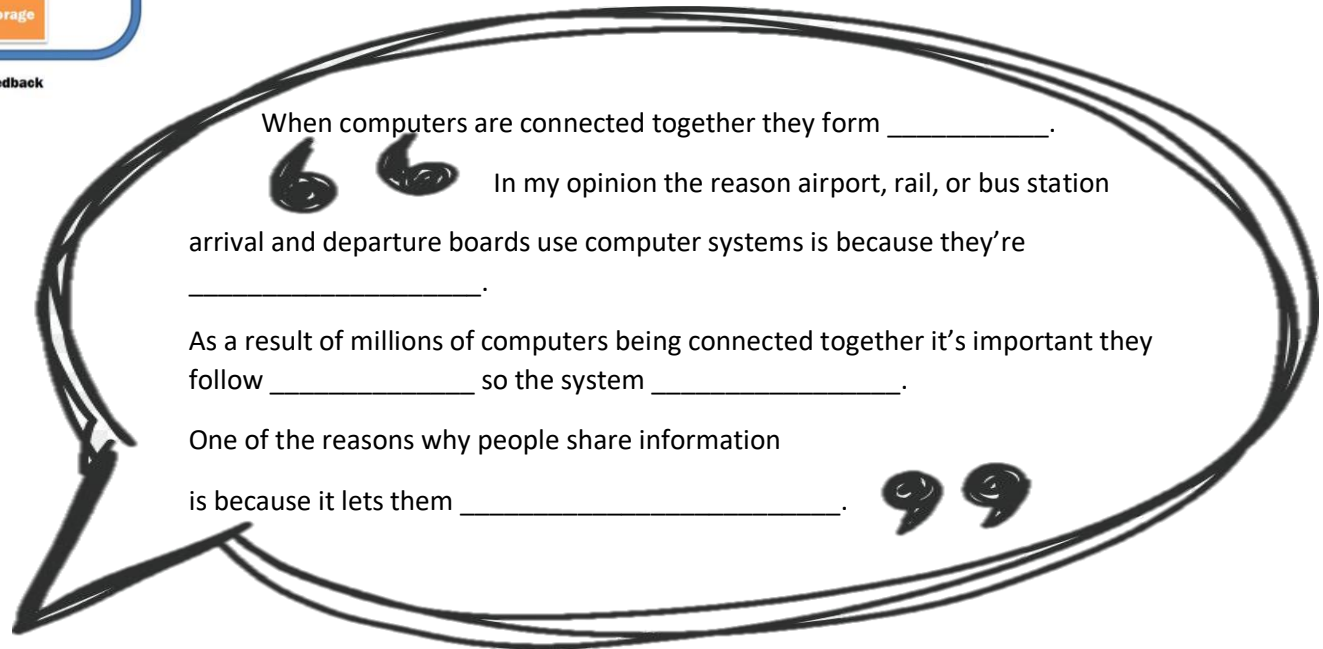
Computer Systems and Networks – Sharing Information
