- websites are created using HTML code
- websites are not programmed. The code isn't run like a set of instructions, instead your browser (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, etc.) reads the 'markup' or code, which tells it how to display the web page on your screen — what things look like, where they are, etc.
- webpages can look different on different devices
- navigation paths are the way that pages are linked together
- links outside your own website are called external links
