

Before Nursery, I have had the opportunity to......

- Take part in finger rhymes with numbers.

- Compare amounts, saying 'lots', 'more' or 'same'.
- Develop counting-like behaviour, such as making sounds, pointing or saying some numbers in sequence.
- Count in everyday contexts, sometimes skipping numbers '1-2-3-5.'
