In EYFS, early maths knowledge focuses mostly on Numbers and Shape, Space and Measure.

This learning is a part of 'Mathematics' – one of the seven core learning areas.

In Nursery, I have had the opportunity to......

- Develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects.
- Recite numbers past 5.
- Say one number for each item in order 1,2,3,4,5
- Show finger numbers up to 5.
- · Link numerals and amounts.
