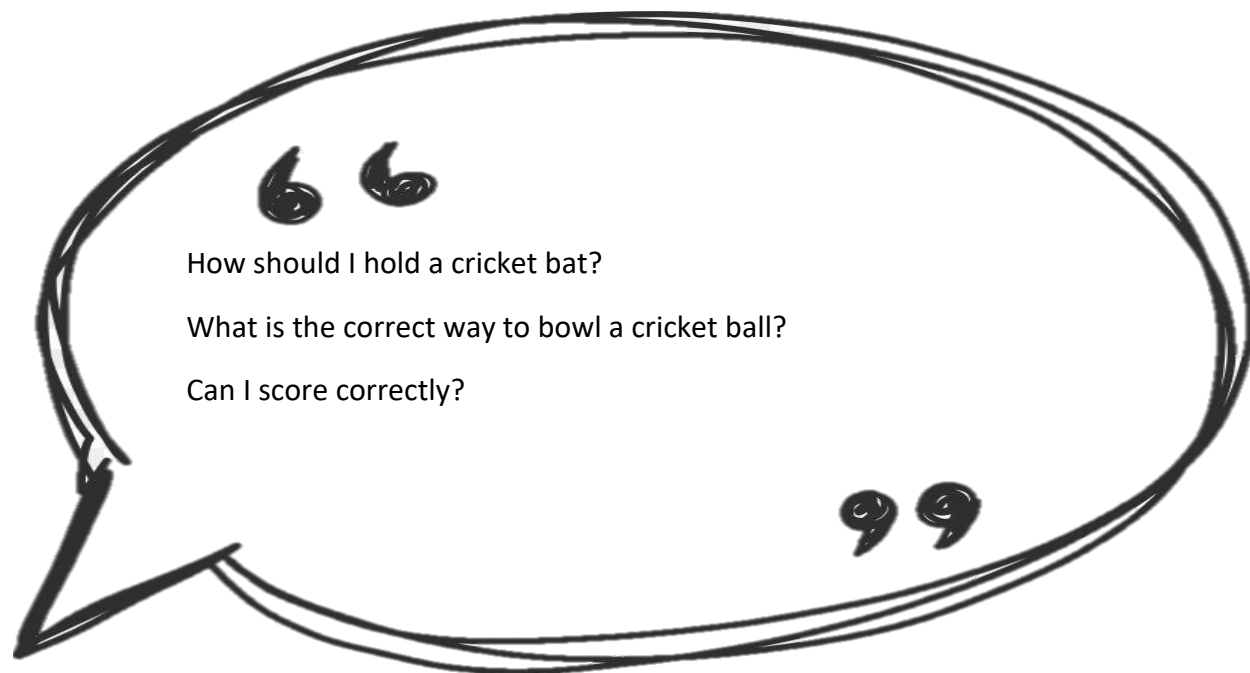

In LKS2, you learnt: How to handle a ball when throwing and catching. How to hit the ball with a cricket bat. You will become familiar with what a match entails.



Key facts	Key skills
Children will build on their knowledge of how to bowl a cricket ball by having an awareness of the seam. They will field in different positions and use their skills to catch and return the ball. Their match play knowledge will be built on and used within small and full team games. All children will experience various positions.	Children will learn how to catch the ball without it touching the group and keeping hold of it. They will be taught how to stop the ball when fielding, and a quick way of how to stop it and pick it up. The elements of good fielding will be built upon as will the position in which the bat should be held for certain shots. They will become aware of the seam which is the stitching around the ball used to help with grip and swinging the ball.
