Next Step Prompt Questions

- How does a plant grow? What happens to a bulb or seed? Can they use one-handed tools and equipment?
- What happens to animals in winter?
- What is the weather like now?
- Why do leaves change colour? Why do trees lose their leaves?
- Can they use materials safely and with increasing control?
- Does the child experiment with blocks, colours and marks?
- Do they sort the pieces by shape, colour or size?
- Can they plan their work?
- Can they use simple tools and techniques with increasing independence?
